



# CANDIDATE ACCEPTANCE and TRAINING POLICY

The Para Practical Shooting Section Candidate Acceptance and Training Policy sets the requirements for new members who wish to participate in the sport of *Practical Shooting* at the Para Branch of SSAA, shooting range.

This policy identifies the procedures required to be conducted to obtain acceptance to participate.

- The following procedures are to be accomplished before persons will be allowed to participate in the *Practical Shooting* training:
  - Letter from SAPOL approving the Training;
  - Current membership of SSAA Para Branch;
  - Current SSAA National Membership;
  - Completion of SSAA Para Branch Safety course or registered to complete the next course.
- On completion of the above, candidates are to register their interest to participate in the training with the Practical Shooting Secretary ([secretary@parapsc.org.au](mailto:secretary@parapsc.org.au)).
- The Secretary will notify the candidate of the date of training.
- The training sessions will comprise theoretical and practical assessments based on the *International Practical Shooting Confederation* (IPSC) rules and procedures.
- The candidate will be subject to training based on:
  - Their current competence
  - Their experience, and
  - The successful completion of the section training assessment for holster proficiency and practical shooting.
- If the candidate passes the assessments (both theoretical and practical) the Training Instructor will provide a notification to the Section Captain, who will notify the Club Secretary, who will then complete and submit the PD314 for H class.
